Connecting an Android Phone to your Bluetooth Speaker:

1. Enable Bluetooth on your phone:

- Open the Settings app on your Android phone.
- Navigate to "Connected devices" or "Connections," then select "Bluetooth".
- Ensure the Bluetooth switch is turned on.

2. Put the speaker into pairing mode:

- For your KSBTS03 module, when you turn the power ON, the module will automatically go into "pairing" mode, for 60 seconds.
- If you are delayed on pairing to it, you may need to turn your module OFF and then ON again.

3. Pair the devices:

- On your phone, go back to the Bluetooth settings and tap "Pair new device" or "Scan" if necessary.
- Your phone will scan for nearby Bluetooth devices.
- Select your speaker from the list of available devices.
- If prompted, enter a PIN or passkey (often "0000" or "1234").
- Your phone will then connect to the speaker.

4. Verify the connection:

- Once paired, your phone should indicate that the speaker is connected in the Bluetooth settings.
- You can now play music or other audio on your phone, and it will be routed through the Bluetooth speaker.
